**DECISION**

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Authority") consulted the following parties on the Application:

- the landowners and their agent
- the applicant
- the Parish Councils
- the Ward Councillors for the area
- user group representatives

All evidence and comments received by the Authority were taken into consideration when making the Decision.

Having considered the evidence and comments, the Authority is satisfied that an Order should be made to show:

- A public footpath commencing from a junction with public footpath BA21/9 at grid reference ST 7660 6890 (Point A on the Decision Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction along a track for approximately 105 metres to a junction with public footpath BA21/9 at grid reference ST 7669 6896 (Point B on the Decision Notice Plan).
- With: 3 metres.
- Limitations: None.
