### BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC BRIDLEWAYS CL6/45 AND CL11/41, GREYFIELD, CLUTTON AND HIGH LITTLETON) MODIFICATION ORDER 2025

The above Order made on 30<sup>th</sup> January 2025, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:

adding to them the bridleway from a junction with Maynard Terrace in Clutton at grid reference ST 6321 5904 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally east-south-easterly direction for approximately 14 metres to a gap adjacent to a locked field gate at grid reference ST 6322 5903 (point B on the Order Map). The route continues in a generally east-south-easterly direction for approximately 380 metres to a junction with public footpath CL6/4 at grid reference ST 6354 5883 (point C on the Order Map). The route continues in a generally east-south-easterly direction for approximately 245 metres to a gap adjacent to a locked vehicle barrier at grid reference ST 6376 5872 (point D on the Order Map). The route continues in a generally east-south-easterly direction for approximately 245 metres to a junction with public footpath CL6/40 at grid reference ST 6397 5859 (point E on the Order Map).

upgrading to bridleway the public right of way from grid reference ST 6397 5859 (point E on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 83 metres to a junction with Greyfield Road in High Littleton at grid reference ST 6404 5864 (point G on the Order Map).

varying the particulars relating to the footpath from Bendalls Bridge and runing in a south-easterly direction to the former railway line. It then continues in an easterly direction across fields to public bridleway CL6/45 at grid reference ST 6354 5883. From the other side of the bridleway it continues on the north side of 'Greyfields' running east into Gores Park.

Please note that all representations received will be considered in public by the Council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it will become available for public inspection.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Bath and North East Somerset Council, instead of submitting the order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the order (or that part of the order). If the order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs, in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with it.
