- adding to them the footpath from a junction with public footpath BA27/79 at ST 6697 6707 and proceeding in a generally N direction for approx. 310m to ST 6703 6736 and turning in a generally E direction for approx. 248m to ST 6728 6733 and turning in a generally N direction for approx. 204m to a junction with public footpath BA27/27b at ST 6729 6753;
- varying the particulars relating to footpaths BA27/27b and BA27/30b.

If the order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs, in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with it.
