

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA27/31, BATH ROAD, KEYNSHAM) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025

On 8 January 2026 the Bath and North East Somerset Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert the section of Public Footpath BA27/31 commencing from grid reference ST 6662 6829 and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approximately 58 metres to a junction with Bath Road at grid reference ST 6662 6823, to a line running from grid reference ST 6662 6829 and proceeding in a generally westerly direction for approximately 26 metres to grid reference ST 6659 6829 and turning in a generally southerly direction for approximately 26 metres to grid reference ST 6660 6826 and turning in a generally south-easterly direction for approximately 35 metres to grid reference ST 6662 6824 and turning in a generally southerly direction for approximately 5 metres to a junction with Bath Road at grid reference ST 6662 6823, as shown on the order map.

The order came into force on 8 January 2026 but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from the date of this notice, make an application to the High Court.
