

## **NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER**

#### **BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL20/29, HAM LANE, STOWEY SUTTON) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025**

The above order, made on 24 April 2025, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert the section of Public Footpath CL20/29 running from grid reference ST 5827 6010 and proceeding in a generally northerly direction for approximately 98 metres to grid reference ST 5828 6020, to a line running from grid reference ST 5827 6010 and proceeding in a generally north-westerly direction for approximately 61 metres to grid reference ST 5824 6015 and then turning in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 67 metres to grid reference ST 5828 6020, as shown on the order map.

If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
