

NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BC43/22, FOX HILL, BATH) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2026

The above order, made on 7 May 2026, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert the section of public footpath running from grid reference ST 7495 6313 and proceeding in a generally east-south-easterly direction for approximately 399 metres to grid reference ST 7531 6297, to a line running from grid reference ST 7495 6313 and proceeding a generally south-south-easterly direction for approximately 14 metres to grid reference ST 7496 6312 and then in a generally easterly direction for approximately 138 metres to grid reference ST 7510 6311 and then in a generally south-easterly direction for approximately 76 metres to grid reference ST 7514 6305 and then in a generally east-south-easterly direction for approximately 188 metres to grid reference ST 7531 6297, as shown on the order map.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Bath and North East Somerset Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
