TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023

Thank you for your email of 9 December 2024. Please quote the new reference number of NATTRAN/SW/TTRO/12154 for all future correspondence.

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby approves of the continuing in force of the above Order made on 21 December 2023, effective from 08 January 2024 and subsequently extended to 05 February 2025.

As there are on-going safety concerns to highway users whilst works to repair the damaged byway surface continue, The Secretary of State now grants a further extension of the said Order until 31 December 2025 or until the completion of the works, whichever is the earlier.

Notice of this extension must be published in the same newspaper in which notice in respect of the Order was published, together with a description of the alternative routes if available.

Please note that should any further extension be requested, you are expected to provide the Secretary of State with evidence as to the progress of the works, together with the reasons for any delays, or a timetable showing the planned works and their expected completion date. If this is not provided, it may delay a decision on your application.
