

NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF ORDER

SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATHS CL3/29, MOORLEDGE LANE, CHEW MAGNA) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024

Notice is given that the order made by Bath and North East Somerset Council on 24th October 2024 will be continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of his powers under section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The order will continue in force until the necessary remedial works have been completed or until 6 November 2026, whichever is the earlier.

The effect of which will be to continue to close the section of Public Footpath CL3/29 commencing from the junction with Public Byway CL3/23 and Public Footpath CL3/31 at grid reference ST 5857 6268 (Point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approximately 527 metres to the junction with Moorledge Lane at grid reference ST 5861 6219 (Point B on the Notice Plan).

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public: namely a newly-formed watercourse, of a sufficient depth and width to cause such a danger, particularly after heavy rain.
