

## **NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE ORDER**

### **SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

#### **BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (CL6/40, GREYFIELD WOODS, CLUTTON) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025**

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intends to make an order the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce a path closure to the section of public footpath CL6/40 commencing from grid reference ST 6388 5841 (point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approximately 415 metres to grid reference ST 6381 5802 (point B on the Notice Plan).

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way; namely, The Woodland Trust are proposing to fell infected larch trees (*Phytophthora Ramorum*) in accordance with a Statutory Plant Health Notice served on The Woodland Trust by the Forestry Commission. The Order will come into force on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2025 and will be effective until 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025. The restriction may not be effected for the whole of the period but only for so long as is necessary to execute the works.
