

# NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE ORDER

## SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

### BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BC65/4, WARMINSTER ROAD, BATH) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intends to make an order the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce a closure to the section of Public Footpath BC65/4 commencing from a junction with Warminster Road at grid reference ST 7617 6556 (point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally north-northwesterly direction for approximately 30 metres to grid reference ST 7616 6559 (point B on the Notice Plan).

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way: namely the applicant will be demolishing an existing building and developing three new homes. The Order will come into force on 5<sup>th</sup> January 2026 and will be effective for six months.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: Warminster Road – Darlington Road – Public Footpath AQ26 - Public Footpath BC65/4. Vice Versa.
