BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BCRIV/1, NELSON VILLAS, KINGSMEAD, BATH) (NO.2) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath BCRIV/1 ("the Footpath") in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all traffic in the Footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the Footpath to facilitate landscaping improvements on behalf of the Council.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

- 1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Footpath BCRIV/1 commencing from the Stanier Road bridge at grid reference ST 7438 6476 (point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approximately 81 metres to Midland Bridge at grid reference ST 7439 6468 (point B on the Order Plan).
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
- 3. This order shall come into operation on 24 November 2025 and will be operative for a period of three weeks. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath BCRIV/1, Nelson Villas, Kingsmead, Bath) (No.2) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025.
