BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC BYWAY CL17/41, BRISTOL ROAD, PUBLOW) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Byway CL17/41 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all traffic in the said public byway should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public: namely the danger caused by a large fallen tree.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

- 1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Byway CL17/41 commencing from the junction with Bristol Road at grid reference ST 6179 6545 (Point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally northeasterly direction for approximately 465 metres to the junction with Blackrock Lane at grid reference ST 6215 6572 (Point B on the Order Plan).
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
- 3. This order shall come into operation on 27 November 2025 and will be operative until 31st January 2026. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset (Public Byway CL17/41, Bristol Road, Publow) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025.
