## BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC BYWAY CL17/41, BRISTOL ROAD, PUBLOW) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made an order to temporarily introduce a closure to the section of Public Byway CL17/41 commencing from the junction with Bristol Road at grid reference ST 6179 6545 (Point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally northeasterly direction for approximately 465 metres to the junction with Blackrock Lane at grid reference ST 6215 6572 (Point B on the Notice Plan).

This temporary closure is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public: namely the danger caused by a large fallen tree. The Order will come into force on 27 November 2025 (continuing the emergency 21-day closure put in place on 6 November 2025) and will be effective until 31 January 2026 (however the byway will be opened sooner if the tree is cleared sooner).


