

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE ORDER

SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATHS BA27/84, BA27/85 & BA27/86, TEMPLE STREET, KEYNSHAM) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intends to make an order the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce a closure: to the section of Public Footpath BA27/84 commencing from grid reference ST 6553 6835 (point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally south-southwesterly direction for approximately 85 metres to a junction with Public Footpath BA27/86 at grid reference ST 6552 6829 (point B on the Notice Plan); to the section of Public Footpath BA27/85 commencing from a junction with Public Footpath BA27/86 at grid reference ST 6551 6832 (point C on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally easterly direction for approximately 29 metres to a junction with Public Footpath BA27/84 at grid reference ST 6554 6833 (point D on the Notice Plan); and to the section of Public Footpath BA27/86 commencing from a junction with Public Footpath BA27/84 at grid reference ST 6552 6829 (point B on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally north-northwesterly direction for approximately 62 metres to grid reference ST 6550 6835 (point E on the Notice Plan).

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way: namely the applicant will be carrying out construction works. The Order will come into force on 11 January 2026 and will be effective until 28 April 2026.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: Temple Street – Public Footpath BA27/19 - Public Footpath BA27/20. Vice Versa.
