

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE ORDER

SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY BC52/2, POPE'S WALK, COMBE DOWN, BATH) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intends to make an order the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce a path closure to the section of Public Bridleway BC52/2 commencing from a junction with Public Footpath BC52/8 at grid reference ST 7584 6285 (point B on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally south-easterly direction for approximately 172 metres to a junction with Footpath BQ51 at grid reference ST 7595 6293 (point C on the Notice Plan).

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the public right of way: namely M J Quinn will be clearing blockages in an Openreach duct. The Order will come into force on 10th March 2026 and will be effective for **four days**.
