(PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY BC52/2, POPE'S WALK, COMBE DOWN, BATH)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Bridleway BC52/2 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all traffic in the said public bridleway should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the bridleway to clear blockages in an Openreach duct.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Bridleway BC52/2 commencing from a junction with Public Footpath BC52/8 at grid reference ST 7584 6285 (point B on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally south-easterly direction for approximately 172 metres to a junction with BQ51 at grid reference ST 7595 6293 (point C on the Order Plan).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. This order shall come into operation on 10 March 2026 and will be operative for four days. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Bridleway BC52/2, Pope's Walk, Combe Down, Bath) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026.
