**BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL
(PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY CL15/11A, CHURCH ROAD, NORTON MALREWARD)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026**

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Bridleway CL15/11a in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all traffic in the said public bridleway should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public: namely the danger caused by a collapsed wall.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Bridleway CL15/11a commencing from a junction with Church Road (Church & Manor Drive) at grid reference ST 6033 6509 (Point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally east-southeasterly direction for approximately 85 metres to a junction with Public Footpath CL15/2 at grid reference ST 6041 6508 (Point B on the Order Plan).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. This order shall come into operation on 10th February 2026, extending the emergency closure of Public Bridleway CL15/11a put in place under Section 14(2) of the Act on 20th January 2026 and will be effective until 20th July 2026. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Bridleway CL15/11a, Church Road, Norton Malreward) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026.
