

# NOTICE OF MAKING OF ORDER

## SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

### BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY CL15/11A, CHURCH ROAD, NORTON MALREWARD) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made an order to temporarily introduce a closure to the section of Public Bridleway CL15/11a commencing from a junction with Church Road (Church & Manor Drive) at grid reference ST 6033 6509 (Point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally east-southeasterly direction for approximately 85 metres to a junction with Public Footpath CL15/2 at grid reference ST 6041 6508 (Point B on the Notice Plan).

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public: namely the danger caused by a collapsed wall.

The Order will come into force on 10<sup>th</sup> February 2026 (continuing the closure that was brought into force by emergency notice on 20<sup>th</sup> January 2026) and will be effective until 20<sup>th</sup> July 2026.
