(PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL20/29, HAM LANE, STOWEY SUTTON)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026**

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath CL20/29 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all traffic in the said public footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the footpath to facilitate pumping station expansion works by Wessex Water.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Footpath CL20/29 commencing from grid reference ST 5827 6010 (point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally northerly direction for approximately 128 metres to a junction with Ham Lane at grid reference ST 5828 6020 (point B on the Order Plan)
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. This order shall come into operation on 19th May 2026 and will be effective for six months. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath CL20/29, Ham Lane, Stowey Sutton) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026.
