

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE ORDER

SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA27/75, BATH HILL, KEYNSHAM) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intends to make an order the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce a closure to the section of Public Footpath BA27/75 commencing from grid reference ST 6554 6847 (point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 35 metres to a junction with Bath Hill at grid reference ST 6557 6849 (point B on the Notice Plan).

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way: namely the applicant will be replacing timber planters. The Order will come into force on 20 April 2026 and will be effective until 31 July 2026.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: Public Footpath BA27/75 – Public Footpath BA27/73 – Bath Hill. Vice Versa.
