(PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA27/75, BATH HILL, KEYNSHAM)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026**

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath BA27/75 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all traffic in the said public footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the footpath to facilitate the replacement of timber planters.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Footpath BA27/75 commencing from grid reference ST 6554 6847 (point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 35 metres to a junction with Bath Hill at grid reference ST 6557 6849 (point B on the Order Plan).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. This order shall come into operation on 20 April 2026 and will be operative until 31 July 2026. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath BA27/75, Bath Hill, Keynsham) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026.
