

SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL
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(PUBLIC FOOTPATH BCRIV/1, NELSON VILLAS, KINGSMEAD, BATH)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath BCRIV/1 ("the Footpath") in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all traffic in the Footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the Footpath to facilitate landscaping improvements on behalf of the Council.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Footpath BCRIV/1 commencing from a junction with Nelson Villas at grid reference ST 7420 6498 (point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally southeasterly direction for approximately 179 metres to grid reference ST 7432 6485 (point C on the Order Plan).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. This order shall come into operation on 29 June 2026 and will be operative until 21 August 2026. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath BCRIV/1, Nelson Villas, Kingsmead, Bath) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026.

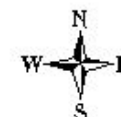
Temporary Footpath Closure
