

# NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE ORDER

## SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

### BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BC26/2, PENN HILL ROAD, BATH) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intends to make an order the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce a closure to the section of Public Footpath BC26/2 commencing from grid reference ST 7263 6631 (point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally easterly direction for approximately 85 metres to a junction with Penn Hill Road at grid reference ST 7271 6631 (point B on the Notice Plan).

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way: namely the applicant will be constructing a zebra crossing at the Penn Hill Road exit of the footpath. The Order will come into force on 29<sup>th</sup> June 2026 and will be effective for four weeks.
