BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC BYWAY BA10/40, DUNKERTON HILL, DUNKERTON) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath BA10/40 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all traffic in the said public byway should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the byway: namely surface improvement works by Bath and North East Somerset Council.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Byway BA10/40 commencing from grid reference ST 7155 5929 (point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally south-southwesterly direction for approximately 411 metres to a junction with Public Footpath BA10/17(fp) and Public Byway BA10/17(bd) at grid reference ST 7137 5893 (point B on the Order Plan).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. This order shall come into operation on 27 July 2026 and shall be operative for four weeks. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Byway BA10/40, Dunkerton Hill, Dunkerton) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026.
