BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA27/47, THE SHALLOWS, SALTFORD) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath BA27/47 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all traffic in the said public footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the public footpath, namely drainage works.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

- 1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Footpath BA27/47 commencing from a junction with The Shallows at grid reference ST 6871 6692 (point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally east-northeasterly direction for approximately 42 metres to grid reference ST 6875 6694 (point B on the Order Plan) and turning in a generally southeasterly direction for approximately 85 metres to grid reference ST 6881 6689 (point C on the Order Plan).
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
- 3. This order shall come into operation on 13 October 2025 and will be operative for a period of four weeks. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath BA27/47, The Shallows, Saltford) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025.
