BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL16/35, HIGH STREET, PAULTON) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath CL16/35 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said public footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the footpath to facilitate surfacing works.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

- 1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Footpath CL16/35 commencing from a junction with Public Footpath CL16/38 at grid reference ST 6507 5625 (point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally easterly direction for approximately 122 metres to grid reference ST 6519 5626 (point B on the Order Plan).
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
- 3. This order shall come into operation on 27th October 2025 and will be operative until 9th November 2025. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath CL16/35, High Street, Paulton) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025.
