

# EXTENSION OF EMERGENCY CLOSURE BY NOTICE TO MOTORISED VEHICLES

## SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

### BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL

Notice is given that the emergency closure, brought into force on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2025 by Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Authority") in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), will be continued **for motorised vehicles** for a further 21 days in accordance with the Authority's powers under section 15(8)(b)(ii) of the Act.

The closure relates to the section of Public Byway CL22/24 commencing from the county border at grid reference ST 5210 5775 (Point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally easterly direction for approximately 473 metres to the junction with Public Footpath CL22/18 and The Sidelings at grid reference ST 5255 5769 (Point B on the Notice Plan).

This temporary closure is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public: namely the danger caused by a steep eroded bank. This emergency closure will remain in place until 26 January 2026 and may thereafter be extended by an Order made under section 14(1) of the Act (if the scheduled repair works take longer to complete than is currently expected).
