BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BC26/2, PENN HILL ROAD, BATH) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath BC26/2 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all traffic in the said public footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the footpath to facilitate the construction of a zebra crossing on Penn Hill Road.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Footpath BC26/2 commencing from grid reference ST 7263 6631 (point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally easterly direction for approximately 85 metres to a junction with Penn Hill Road at grid reference ST 7271 6631 (point B on the Order Plan).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. This order shall come into operation on 29 June 2026 and will be operative for a period of four weeks. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath BC26/2, Penn Hill Road, Bath) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026.
