### **BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL16/1, OXLEAZE WAY, PAULTON) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026**

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath CL16/1 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all traffic in the said public footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the footpath: namely the altering of the line of an outflow pipe.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Footpath CL16/1 commencing from grid reference ST 6447 5687 (point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 94 metres to grid reference ST 6452 5693 (point B on the Order Plan).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. This order shall come into operation on 3 August 2026 and shall be operative for two days. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath CL16/1, Oxleaze Way, Paulton) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026.
