DECISION

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Authority") consulted the following parties on the Application:

- the known landowners
- the applicants
- the Town Council
- the Ward Councillors for the area

All evidence and comments received by the Authority were taken into consideration when making the Decision.

Having considered the evidence and comments, the Authority is satisfied that an Order should be made to show:

- A public footpath commencing from a junction with public footpath BA27/5 at grid reference ST 6536 6905 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally north-westerly direction adjacent to the Great Western Railway for approximately 158 metres to grid reference ST 6523 6914 (point B on the Order Map) and turning in a generally north-easterly direction under the railway line for approximately 58 metres to a junction with public footpath BA27/87 at grid reference ST 6527 6918 (point D on the Order Map).
- Width: 1.8 metres
- Limitations: The right of the landowner to erect and maintain a stile at grid reference ST 6526 6917

on the Definitive Map and Statement of Rights of Way in Bath and North East Somerset.
