DECISION

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Authority") consulted the following parties on the Application:

All evidence and comments received by the Authority were taken into consideration when making the Decision.

Having considered the evidence and comments, the Authority is satisfied that an Order should be made to show:

- a public footpath commencing from a junction with public footpath BA2/3 at grid reference ST 7737 6697 (Point A on the Decision Plan) and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approximately 48 metres to the northern bank of the River Avon at ST 7738 6692 (Point B on the Decision Plan),
- with a width of 2 metres throughout,
- and no limitations or conditions,

on the Definitive Map and Statement of Rights of Way in Bath and North East Somerset.

The effect of this is shown on the attached plan.
