

**Investigation into evidence
Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981**

MEADOW PARK, BATHFORD

DECISION

Bath and North East Somerset Council (“the Authority”) consulted the following parties on the Application:

- the landowners
- the applicant/Parish Council
- the Ward Councillors for the area
- local user groups

All evidence and comments received by the Authority were taken into consideration when making the Decision.

Having considered the evidence and comments, the Authority is satisfied that an Order should be made to show:

- a public footpath commencing from a junction with Meadow Park at grid reference ST 7869 6731 (point A on the Decision Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally easterly direction predominantly over a concrete path for approximately 105 metres to a junction with public footpath BA3/24 at grid reference ST 7879 6731 (Point C on the Decision Plan);
 - a width of 1.3 metres between ST 7869 6731 (point A on the Decision Notice Plan) and ST 7878 6731 (point B on the Decision Notice Plan) and varying between 1.3 metres and 3 metres between grid reference ST 7878 6731 (Point B on the Decision Plan) and grid reference ST 7879 6731 (Point C on the Decision Plan) as shown shaded grey on the Decision Plan;
 - the right of the landowner to erect and maintain a 1.8 metre wide gate at grid reference ST 7879 6731 (Point C on the Decision Notice Plan);
- on the Definitive Map and Statement of Rights of Way in Bath and North East Somerset.


The effect of this is shown on the attached plan.
