Footpaths off Lyncombe Vale Road, Bath

Thank you very much for your letter dated the 4th April.

I enclose a copy of a plan showing a section of the public footpath which I have coloured in green, which has been completely blocked (for about three months now) by the owners of the land with material taken from the woodland which they are at present "tidying".

Attempts have also been made more recently to block off the public footpath which I have shown coloured red on the plan at points at each end of that section of the footpath. Notices have also been put up (which now seem to have come down, but which may re-appear at any time) indicating the sections of footpath which I have coloured green and red are not public footpaths.

I would be grateful if you would write to the school or their Solicitors requiring them to clear that section of the footpath shown coloured green on the enclosed plan which has been blocked, and to desist from their attempts to block that section of the footpath coloured red on the enclosed plan.

I would also be grateful if you would arrange for the public footpaths to be sign-posted under the provisions of Section 27 of the Countryside Act 1968, as amended by Section 65 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.
