Footpaths off Lyncombe Vale Road, Bath

I refer you to my letter of 25 November 1983 to which I do not appear to have received a reply. A copy of that letter is enclosed. If your client wishes the paths to be waymarked as I suggested, then I would advise you that the signposts are to be erected where the paths leave Lyncombe Vale Road within the next month, and a waymarking scheme could be implemented at the same time. This will of course depend on your reply to the above-mentioned letter.

It has been brought to my attention also, that trees have been felled on the land surrounding the footpaths. I understand that the felled tree trunks and branches have been left so as to block one the footpaths - between points A and B shown on the attached plan. In view of the public right of way status accorded to the path, this action constitutes an offence under s137 of the Highways Act 1980. I would be obliged if you would bring this information to your clients attention and advise them that the obstructions should be removed forthwith.
