Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 - Section 53 Order Making Authority: Bath and North East Somerset Council Title of Order: (City of Bath Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order) (No. 17 - Widcombe) 2019

Further to my recent letter, we have not received any comments on the submitted statements of case.

The exchange period has now ended. Arrangements have therefore been made for the Inspector to visit the site.

As previously advised, the purpose of the visit is to enable the Inspector to see the land to which the Order relates, the surrounding area and to note physical features such as stiles, gates, fences, walls, hedges and trees. The Inspector will visit the site, unaccompanied by the parties, during the week of 8th November 2021. The time and date on which the visit actually takes place will be at the discretion of the Inspector.

As the exchange of written representations has been completed, the Inspector will not discuss the case with anyone he/she meets. The Inspector will refuse any approach that is made.
