BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (RESTRICTED BYWAY BA21/12, BEEKS MILL, ST CATHERINE) DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2017

The above Order made on 2nd August 2017, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them the restricted byway from a junction with St Catherine Lane at grid reference ST 7611 7106 and continuing in a generally northeasterly direction for approximately 200 metres along a track to the county boundary with South Gloucestershire at grid reference ST 7624 7121.

Any representation or objection relating to the order must be sent in writing to the Public Rights of Way Team, Bath and North East Somerset Council, Lewis House, Manvers Street, Bath, BA1 1JG not later than **22nd September 2017** and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made. Please note that all representations received will be considered in public by the Council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it will become available for public inspection.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Bath and North East Somerset Council, instead of submitting the order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the order (or that part of the order). If the order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs, in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with it.
