This Order is made by Bath and North East Somerset Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ('the Act') because it appears to that authority that the City of Bath Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i), namely, that rights of way which are not shown in the map and statement subsist or are reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being rights of way such that the land over which the rights subsist are public paths.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Bath and North East Somerset Council hereby order that:

- 1. For the purposes of this order the relevant date is 11th July 2017.
- 2. The City of Bath Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.

This order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council City of Bath Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order (No. 12 – Twerton) 2017.

The footpath continues up the steps for a distance of approximately 8 metres to point C at Grid Reference ST 7158 6442 and continues for a distance of approximately 3 metres to point D at Grid Reference ST 7159 6441 where the direction changes to south-easterly. The footpath continues for a distance of approximately 6 metres to steps at point E at Grid Reference ST 7159 6441. The footpath continues up the steps for a distance of approximately 6 metres to point F at Grid Reference ST 7160 6441 and continues for a distance of approximately 13 metres to steps at point G at Grid Reference ST 7160 6440. BC24/13
