BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA27/31, BATH ROAD, KEYNSHAM) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025

The above order, made on 11 September 2025, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert the section of Public Footpath BA27/31 commencing from grid reference ST 6662 6829 and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approximately 58 metres to a junction with Bath Road at grid reference ST 6662 6823, to a line running from grid reference ST 6662 6829 and proceeding in a generally westerly direction for approximately 26 metres to grid reference ST 6659 6829 and turning in a generally southerly direction for approximately 26 metres to grid reference ST 6660 6826 and turning in a generally south-easterly direction for approximately 35 metres to grid reference ST 6662 6824 and turning in a generally southerly direction for approximately 5 metres to a junction with Bath Road at grid reference ST 6662 6823, as shown on the order map.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Bath and North East Somerset Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
