The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert that section of Public Footpath CL20/29 running from grid reference ST 5827 6010 and proceeding in a generally northerly direction for approximately 98 metres to grid reference ST 5828 6020, to a line running from grid reference ST 5827 6010 and proceeding in a generally northwesterly direction for approximately 61 metres to grid reference ST 5824 6015 and then turning in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 67 metres to grid reference ST 5828 6020, as shown on the order map.

The order came into force on 7 August 2025 but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from the date of this notice, make an application to the High Court.
