BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL4/18, MILL LANE, CHEW STOKE) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023

The above order, made on 17th August 2023 under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert a section of public footpath commencing from its junction with Mill Lane at grid reference ST 5567 6175 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally north northwesterly direction for approximately 26 metres to grid reference ST 5566 6178 (point D on the Order Map) and continuing in a generally northwesterly direction for approximately 126 metres to grid reference ST 5558 6187 (point C on the Order Map) to a line running from a junction with Mill Lane at grid reference ST 5567 6175 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally northwesterly direction for approximately 146 metres to grid reference ST 5558 6187 (point C on the Order Map), as shown on the order map.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Bath and North East Somerset Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
