

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER

(PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL4/18, MILL LANE, CHEW STOKE)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023**

On 23rd November 2023 the Bath and North East Somerset Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert the section of public footpath CL4/18 commencing from its junction with Mill Lane at grid reference ST 5567 6175 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally north northwesterly direction for approximately 26 metres to grid reference ST 5566 6178 (point D on the Order Map) and continuing in a generally northwesterly direction for approximately 126 metres to grid reference ST 5558 6187 (point C on the Order Map) to a line running from a junction with Mill Lane at grid reference ST 5567 6175 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally northwesterly direction for approximately 146 metres to grid reference ST 5558 6187 (point C on the Order Map), as shown on the order map.

The order came into force on 23rd November 2023 but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from the date of this notice, make an application to the High Court.
