BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL17/5, BIRCHWOOD LANE, PENSFORD) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023

The above order, made on 15th June 2023, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert the section of public footpath CL17/5 running from grid reference ST 6255 6276 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally east southeasterly direction for approximately 109 metres to its junction with Birchwood Lane at grid reference ST 6266 6271 (point B on the Order Map) to a line running from grid reference ST 6255 6276 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally south southeasterly direction for approximately 88 metres to its junction with Birchwood Lane at grid reference ST 6261 6269 (point C on the Order Map), as shown on the order map.

Please state the grounds on which they are made. Please note that all representations received may be considered in public by the Council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it will become available for public inspection.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Bath and North East Somerset Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
