

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL6/38, MARSH LANE, CLUTTON) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2022

On 23 February 2023 Bath and North East Somerset Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert the public footpath running from grid reference ST 6337 5764, proceeding in a generally east north-easterly direction for approximately 46 metres to grid reference ST 6341 5766 and then turning in a generally east south-easterly direction for approximately 124 metres to a junction with public footpath CL6/37 at grid reference ST 6352 5760, to a line running from grid reference ST 6337 5764 and proceeding in a generally south south-easterly direction for approximately 38 metres to grid reference ST 6338 5760 and then turning in a generally east north-easterly direction for approximately 41 metres to grid reference ST 6342 5762 and then turning in a generally south south-easterly direction for approximately 40 metres to a junction with public footpath CL6/37 at grid reference ST 6344 5758, as shown on the order map.

The order came into force on 23 February 2023 but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from the date of this notice, make an application to the High Court.
