

## NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER

### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

#### **BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL6/38, MARSH LANE, CLUTTON) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2022**

The above order, made on 8 September 2022 under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert the public footpath running from grid reference ST 6337 5764, proceeding in a generally east north-easterly direction for approximately 46 metres to grid reference ST 6341 5766 and then turning in a generally east south-easterly direction for approximately 124 metres to a junction with public footpath CL6/37 at grid reference ST 6352 5760, to a line running from grid reference ST 6337 5764 and proceeding in a generally south south-easterly direction for approximately 38 metres to grid reference ST 6338 5760 and then turning in a generally east north-easterly direction for approximately 41 metres to grid reference ST 6342 5762 and then turning in a generally south south-easterly direction for approximately 40 metres to a junction with public footpath CL6/37 at grid reference ST 6344 5758, as shown on the order map.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Bath and North East Somerset Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
