BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL24/41, PIT PATH, WESTFIELD) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2022

The above order, made on 21st April 2022, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert the section of Public Footpath CL24/41 commencing from grid reference ST 6700 5416 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally east northeasterly direction for approximately 197 metres to grid reference ST 6718 5426 (point B on the Order Map) and turning in a generally southeasterly direction for approximately 6 metres to grid reference ST 6718 5425 (point C on the Order Map) to a line running from grid reference ST 6700 5416 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally east northeasterly direction for approximately 202 metres to grid reference ST 6718 5425 (point C on the Order Map), as shown on the order map.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Bath and North East Somerset Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
