FOR THE ATTENTION OF ALL PUBLIC FOOTPATH USERS

Bath and North East Somerset Council are proposing to change the Public Rights of Way network in respect of public footpath CL17/25, Blackrock Lane, Publow, in the Parish of Publow with Pensford



The general effect of the proposal is shown on the plan above. The section of Public Footpath CL17/25 from grid reference ST 6237 6476 at point A on the above plan in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 123 metres to a junction with Blackrock Lane at ST 6226 6471 at point B, would be stopped up. This is shown on the above plan by a solid red line.

The new line of the public footpath would run from point A in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 122 metres to a junction with Blackrock Lane at ST 6226 6471 at point C. This is shown on the above plan by a solid green line.

These changes are proposed in the interests of the landowner as they would take the footpath out of the landowner's drive to improve safety and privacy and divert the walker on to the more direct route through a field. The changes would be achieved by way of a diversion order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ('the Act'). The new path would be created without any limitations, however it is intended to authorise the erection of kissing gates at field boundaries under section 147 of the Act, to prevent the ingress and egress of livestock.
