FOR THE ATTENTION OF ALL PUBLIC FOOTPATH USERS

Bath and North East Somerset Council are proposing to change the Public Rights of Way network in respect of Public Footpath BA19/22, at Skylark Farm, in the Parish of Peasedown St John.

The general effect of the proposal is shown on the attached Plan. Public Footpath (FP) BA19/22 currently runs between the poultry buildings and over numerous steps at Skylark Farm. The proposal reroutes this section of FP to the southeast of the poultry farm through woodland to join FP BA19/21 at a point further southeast. The section of FP BA19/22 to be stopped up runs from point A on the Plan at grid reference ST 7060 5574 to point B at grid reference ST 7051 5606 and is shown as a continuous red line on the Plan. The proposed FP runs from point A to point C at grid reference ST 7074 5590 and is shown as a continuous green line on the Plan.

The changes would be achieved by way of a diversion order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ('the Act') and are proposed in the interests of the landowner in order to improve farm management and provide a more pleasant and accessible route for public use away from farm buildings.
