BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL11/26, HALLATROW, HIGH LITTLETON) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020

This order is made by Bath and North East Somerset Council under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpath to which this order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely: development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission 15/01335/OUT and 19/00035/RES (Residential Housing).

BY THIS ORDER:

- The footpath over the land shown by a bold line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be diverted as provided below.
- There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of Bath and North East Somerset Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached map.
- 3. The diversion of the footpath shall have effect on the date on which Bath and North East Somerset Council certify that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with.
- 4. The following works shall be carried out in relation to the highway described in Part 2 of the Schedule:
 - i. Surfacing of footpath with tarmac;
 - ii. Replacement of stile at point A with metal kissing gate;
 - iii. Removal of metal kissing gate by point B.
- 5. Shepperton Builders Limited is hereby required to pay for the said works.
- 6. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY


The full width of the section of Public Footpath CL11/26 commencing from grid reference ST 6353 5705 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approximately 13 metres to grid reference ST 6353 5704 (point C on the Order Map).

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF ALTERNATIVE HIGHWAY

A public footpath commencing from grid reference ST 6353 5705 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approximately 12 metres to grid reference ST 6353 5704 (point B on the Order Map) and then in a generally westerly direction for approximately 4 metres to ST 6353 5704 (point C on the Order Map).

Width: 2 metres between grid references ST 6353 5705 (point A on the Order Map) and ST 6353 5704 (point C on the Order Map).



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
