

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER**

**BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL9-36,  
BATH ROAD, FARMBOROUGH) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2019**

On 12 December 2019 Bath and North East Somerset Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert that section of the public footpath running from grid reference ST 6538 6038 and proceeding in a generally easterly direction for approximately 128 metres to a junction with Public Footpath CL9/42 and Bath Road at grid reference ST 6550 6039, to a new line running from grid reference ST 6538 6038 and proceeding in a generally east-north-easterly direction for approximately 125 metres to a junction with Public Footpath CL9/42 at grid reference ST 6550 6042, as shown on the order map.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at The One Stop Shop at The Hollies, High Street, Midsomer Norton during normal office hours. The order came into force on 12 December 2019 but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from the date of this notice, make an application to the High Court.
