- The public footpath running from grid reference ST 5472 5893 and proceeding in a generally northerly direction, via point G on Order Plan 2, for approximately 92 metres to grid reference ST 5470 5901 to a new line running from grid reference ST 5472 5893 and proceeding in a generally northerly direction for approximately 88 metres, via point J on Order Plan 2, to grid reference ST 5470 5901,

as shown on the order maps.
